Phoenix Private Academy supports students with diverse learning, communication, behavioural, and developmental needs.

Our small class sizes and low student-to-teacher ratios allow us to provide individualized support and adapt learning to each student's strengths and challenges.

Phoenix is a good fit for students who have struggled in mainstream school settings and need a more supportive, structured, ABA environment or IBI therapies to succeed academically, socially, and personally.

We work with students with Autism Spectrum Disorder, language impairments, intellectual disabilities, dyslexia, Down Syndrome, behavioural needs, multiple exceptionalities, and more.



OUR PROGRAMS

Academic Stream

At Phoenix, reading, writing, spelling, math, and comprehension are taught through evidence-based Direct Instruction programs. This structured approach uses carefully planned lessons, small learning steps, and ongoing review to build skills, confidence, and successful learning.

Students are grouped by both grade and skill level so instruction can be tailored to individual needs and abilities.

Phoenix follows the Ontario Ministry of Education curriculum while adapting teaching strategies to support exceptional learners. In addition to academics, students participate in social skills activities, physical education, DPA, swimming, and art programs that support creativity, communication, independence, and overall well-being.

Applied Stream and Life Skills Class

These classes are designed for students in Grades 1–6, with a focus on communication, social interaction, and everyday functioning skills. The program helps students build the academic, social, and communication skills needed to progress toward their educational goals. Students work on skills such as making friends, interacting and playing with others, emotional regulation, asking for help, personal safety, and following school routines.

The Junior/Intermediate Life Skills Class

The class uses a modified curriculum to support greater independence at home, school, and in the community. Students develop practical living and work-related skills, including personal care, household chores, community living, occupational skills, self-awareness and essential math and reading.
